Start Python IDLE and type in the following code in the script mode window:

```
# Grades Calculator
score = int(input("Enter your score:"))
if score >= 80:
    print("Great score, well done!")
elif score >= 50:
    print("Not bad, could do better.")
else:
    print("Oh dear!")
```

Now change your program as follows. Test it several times to make sure that it works.

```
# Grades Calculator
score = int(input("Enter your score:"))
if score >= 80:
    print("Grade A")
elif score >= 70:
    print("Grade B")
elif score >= 60:
    print("Grade C")
else:
    print("Oh dear!")
```
