## Our intent

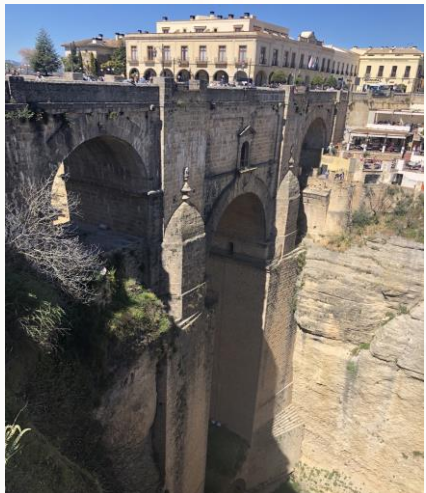
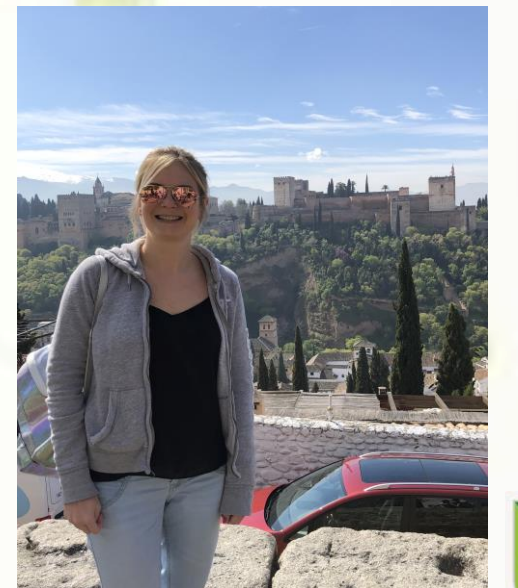
Learning a foreign language opens young people to other cultures and provides the foundation for learning further languages, equipping pupils to study and work in other countries and developing them as global citizens.

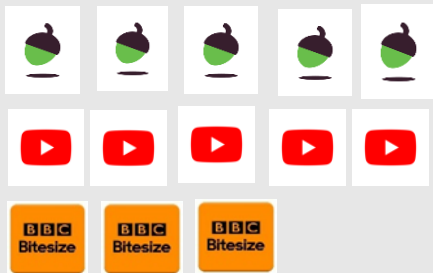

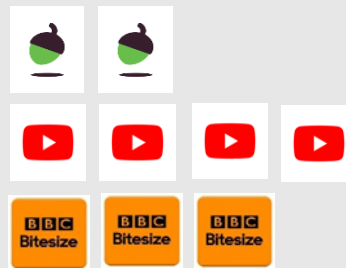

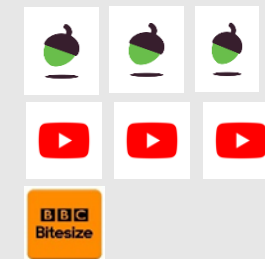
