Year 5

COLOUR THEORY

KS3 Art will build on the art skills and techniques you have developed in Years 5 and 6 to prepare you for GCSE study.

Textiles
You will learn lots of different stitches and create your own hand stitched piece of work.

Sgraffito
Create your own sgraffito work using line and pattern

Observation studies
Creating realistic observational studies using different media and combing the understanding of the visual elements studied

Exploring an Artist
You will discover the work of Sarah Graham and work in her style creating your own work inspired by her

Year 7

Observational Studies
Creating realistic observational studies (fruit and vegetables) using different media and combing the understanding of the visual elements studied in KS2 and KS3 date

Painting and mixed media
You will develop your upscaling, compositional, and painting skills to create you own work - this will then be further developed by use of mixed media

Printing
You will develop your printing skills and techniques . Compare the printing work of artists such as Morris

Manipulation of images
You will learn about tourist landmarks and role play skills to practise discussing future travels.
