

## Home Learning/Remote Education

In the event of your child not being able to attend school, with prior notification/agreement with the school, we can provide the facility of working on materials that are on our online portal, if work has not already been sent home.

Please follow these instructions:

- Under the 'academic' tab, click on 'curriculum and assessment details'
- This then opens up a list of different subjects
- Ask your child to follow their normal timetable for that day/week
- Go into the relevant subject (e.g. if they would normally have Art period one, click on that)
- In here, you will find the '(subject selected) curriculum presentation' and '(subject selected) learning journey'. Click on the curriculum presentation one
- This will open up a power point with all the years and study units for each term. Find the year and term that the student is currently in (split into 6 half terms) e.g. if it was Art, year 5 and spring 1, you will see that there are the 'key elements' and then an activity to cover at the bottom in the 'additional curriculum resources' section, which the student can cover
- Spend only the time on that subject that would normally be allocated in school (e.g. if it was Art, period one, then it would be one hour etc)
- For additional work, there are a number of additional English 'Extra Resources' that are split into key stage 2 and 3. Again, use the same tab area but go into the English section, where there are numerous links before you get to the main power point
- Other sites to use can be 'BBC Revisewise' keep to either key stage 2 or 3, according to what year your child is in – and 'Oak National Academy', which is full of different activities for students to access
