Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware, at the end of every term the students have the opportunity to attend a reward trip. We have ensured that the trips represents our behaviour policy so that only those pupils who have displayed consistently good behaviour over the term (by achieving less than 10 behaviour points) are rewarded. Those who have acquired 10 or more behaviour points over the term will stay in school and will be taught by the remaining staff. In the new term, everybody gets a fresh start and it is our hope that those pupils who did not manage to achieve the whole- school target can do so in the following term enabling them to attend the next reward activity.

For the spring term, the reward trip for KS2 is an afternoon Ninja Warrior in Hanley. The Year 5 trip will take place during the afternoon of Tuesday 5th April and the Year 6 trip during the afternoon of Wednesday 6th April. We are asking for a contribution of £15.50 per child, to cover the cost of coaches to and from the venue and entrance to the facility including socks. This is to be paid via ParentPay.

We are aiming to arrive at the venue for 1pm and will aim to be back before the end of the school day so their usual transport will not be affected.

Unless sufficient contributions are forthcoming, the activity will not be able to take place and any contributions made will be refunded in full. All pupils will be treated the same whether or not a contribution has been received.
